Principal Report written by Josh Webb

Good morning Oaklands school community,

Welcome to the commencement of Term 2. I hope you all had a safe and relaxing holiday.

Events at the end of last Term and the beginning of this term included:

- The Easter Activities afternoon was excellent, a lot of fantastic hats, craft and yummy food was made and eaten!
- The ANZAC Day school ceremony was run by our SRC students this year. Well done to everyone who helped organise the event.
- A wonderful effort by the school community for their support of school students in the Vouch for Lismore - Fundraiser. Lismore has been devastated by the flooding crisis of 2022. The scale of damage across all aspects of the community has been unfathomable. The most significant part for the high school sector has been the complete inundation of the Richmond River Campus. The entire school has been covered by flood waters and is now uninhabitable for at least 12 months. The students and staff have lost everything they own and now face a very long road to recovery. The Vouch for Lismore—Fundraiser aim to access as many vouchers to supply to the families in need. Vouchers for the businesses and the school community so they can access what they need, when they need it. This all helps put money back into the local economy. The money raised will go to their transition back into full time schooling.

Updates to COVID-19

\Rightarrow Changes to isolation for close contacts

From Friday 22nd April, 2022, close contacts (including household contacts) can leave home isolation with certain restrictions. From Week 1 Term 2, students identified as close contacts will be able to attend school with the following mitigations in place.

- You must notify the school if your child has identified as close contacts and is intending to return to school.
- Your child should conduct a daily rapid antigen test (RAT) and return a negative result each morning before attending school for 5 school days to minimise the risk of transmission.
- Secondary students must wear a mask indoors except when eating or exercising. Primary school students are recommended to wear a mask indoors (except when eating or exercising).
- No student or staff member identified as a close contact will be permitted to participate in overnight excursions, including school camps.

Rapid Antigen Testing

Additional RATs will be dispatched to schools to support staff and families to comply with daily testing requirements for close contacts returning to school. Kits can be used for symptomatic testing or for daily testing as part of the close contact requirements.
