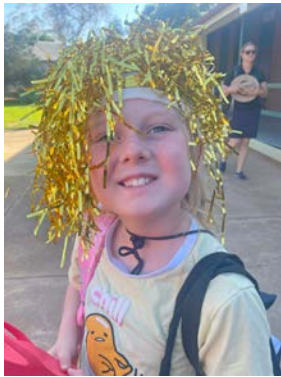

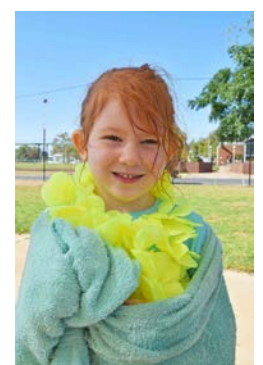

Finley Zone PSSA Swimming Carnival

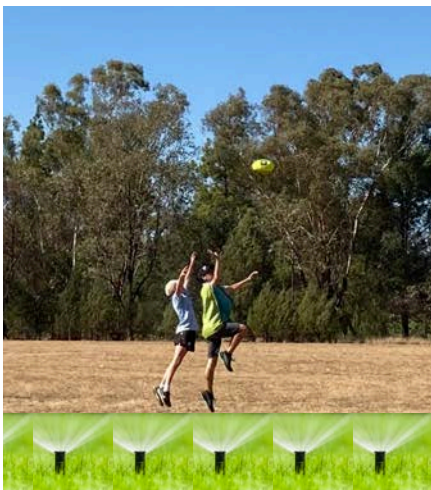


Our Relay Team - Blake, Hudson, Sophie and Annabelle competed in the Earl McGee relay race and broke the standing record.

Liam's journey to recovery

Incident on the playground

Liam, a 10-year-old student, was enjoying a game of soccer with his friends during lunchtime when he twisted his knee. The teacher on duty immediately saw the accident and notified the school administration.

Medical response and treatment

Liam was taken to the emergency room, where he was diagnosed with a ruptured anterior cruciate ligament. He underwent surgery to repair the injury. Post-surgery, Liam received a prescription for medication, a shower chair, and crutches to assist him during the initial recovery phase.

Road to recovery

Two weeks after surgery, Liam began physiotherapy sessions as advised by his doctor. During these sessions, he transitioned to using a knee brace, which provided increased mobility and allowed him to return to school.

Support and care

Thanks to the swift actions of the school staff and the medical care he received, Liam was able to focus on his recovery and return to his normal activities with confidence.

Claimable expenses

For Liam's family there were some claimable expenses including:

- Non-medicare medical expenses (not covered by private health insurance), up to \$7,500, included hospital expenses, physiotherapy and prescription medication
- Out of pocket expenses, up to \$300, including car parking costs for appointments, crutches, shower chair and knee brace
- A cash benefit, up to \$1,500 (capped at \$100/day), was paid during the time Liam was unable to attend school to assist the family with care

Benefits overview

Benefit payment examples*

- Broken bones
- Loss of teeth and dental procedures
- Home and vehicle modifications

Out-of-pocket expenses*

Up to \$300: This covers travel costs associated with treatment, medical support items (e.g., moon boots and crutches), replacement of damaged items, and more.

Non-medicare medical expenses*

Up to \$7,500: Not all medical expenses are covered by Medicare, so AHI will cover some of these additional expenses.

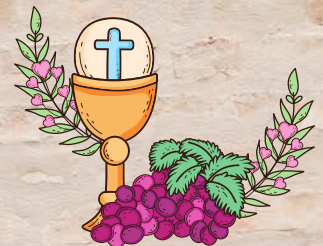
